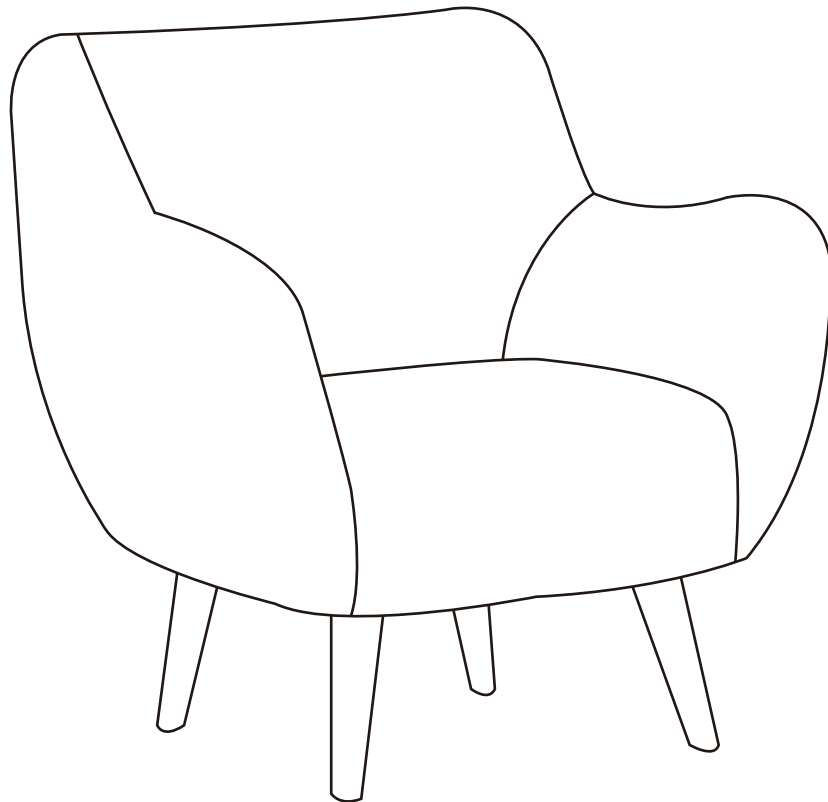

Before you start

Thank you for purchasing this Jacob Bedside.

Please read these instructions fully prior to assembly to familiarise yourself with the various stages of construction. Carefully open all packs supplied and check the contents against the parts and fittings check list.

Do not destroy any of the packaging until you are certain that you have all the necessary parts for the assembly.

This item is heavy once assembled. Please try to assemble the item as close as possible to the point of use. Take care when moving the item to avoid personal injury or damage to the product and always lift rather than drag.

There are small components used in the construction of this furniture as well as plastic packaging, these should be kept away from young children whilst assembling.

Product Safety

All assembly fastenings should always be tightened properly, and care should be taken to ensure that no fittings are loose.

Periodically check and ensure that all components are in their proper position, free from damage, and that all connectors are tight.

Please note depending on the lighting, positioning and surroundings of your room, the shade of the colour can sometimes appear slightly different. Over a period of time the colour might lighten or fade slightly due to light exposure.

Product Care

To clean, slightly moisten cloth with water and wipe surfaces. A damp cloth holds dust and prevents damage. Repeat with a dry, soft, lint-free cloth. Do not use abrasives or cleaning products which may contain ammonia or solvents.





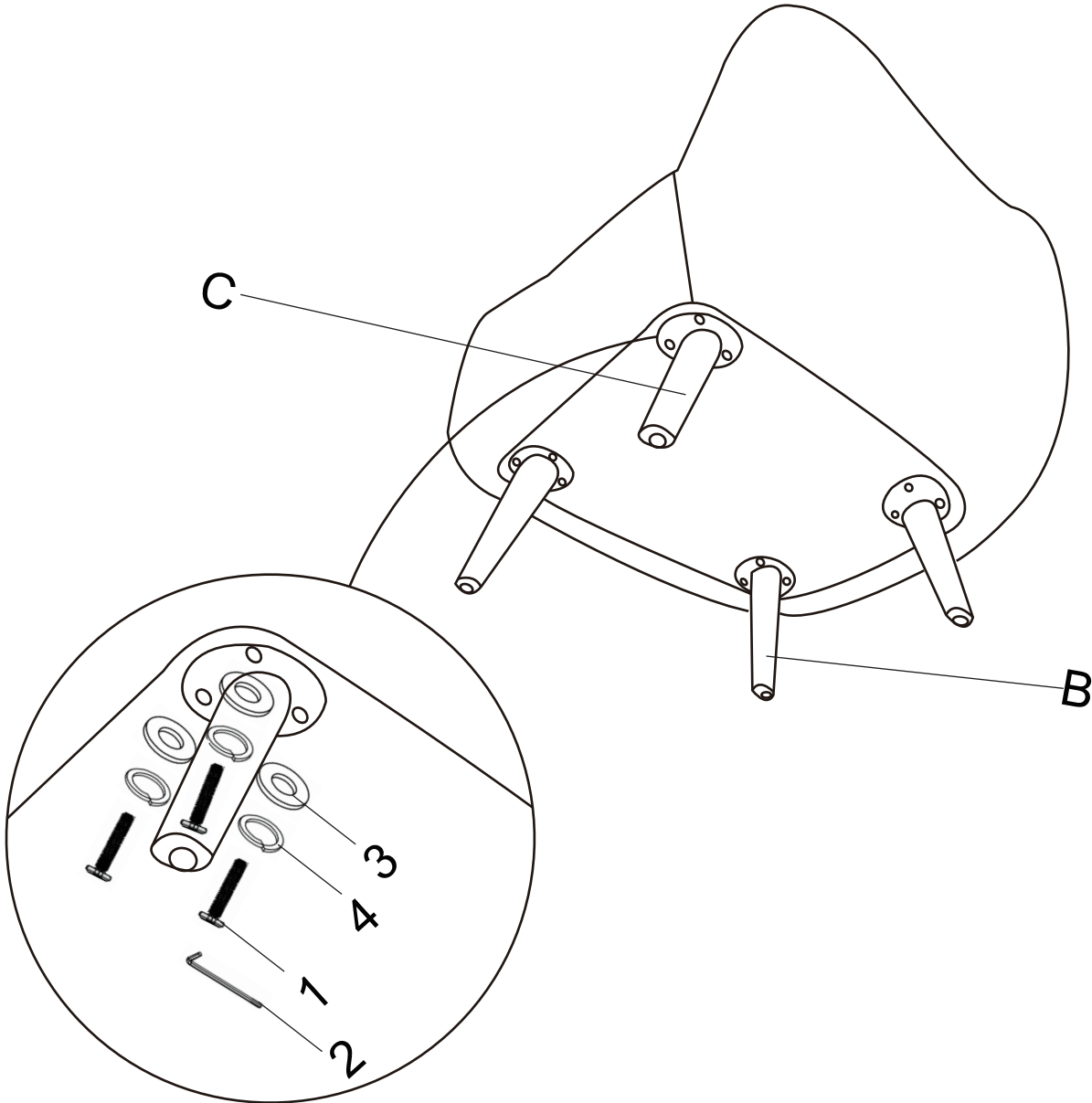

Caring for your upholstery

Precautions:

- **Avoid undue weight on frames:** Preserve the structural integrity of your furniture by refraining from sitting on the backs and arms of sofas and chairs.
- **Optimal placement for heat and sunlight:** Position your furniture at least 50cm away from direct heat sources such as radiators, fires, and air conditioning units. Shield them from excessive sunlight to protect the upholstery from fading or deteriorating and preserve its vibrant hue.
- **Proper handling:** Lift sofas and chairs carefully by their bases when repositioning them to protect the frames and legs. Avoid dragging or pulling by the arms.
- **Protection from potential hazards:** Exercise caution with items such as buckles, toys, jewellery, and pet claws, which can snag and tear fabrics. Be particularly mindful of cleaning products and clothing dyes, such as those from dark denim jeans and tanning lotions, as they may transfer and cause irreversible stains.

Care and maintenance:

- **Ensuring even wear:** Rotate the cushions regularly and make sure you sit on every seat – not just your preferred spot!
- **Cushion care:** Avoid perching on the edges of cushions to maintain their supportive structure and shape.
- **Daily plumping:** Keep seat and back cushions in pristine condition by plumping and straightening them daily.
- **Spill management:** Swift action is required. Do not rub or soak the fabric or allow the stain to set. Use a clean, white absorbent cloth to gently blot liquid spills. For solid spills, carefully remove any excess with a blunt knife or spatula, then dab the stain carefully. Avoid harsh cleaning agents such as washing-up liquid, detergents, or bleach. Always refer to the manufacturer's care instructions and test any specialist upholstery cleaner on a discreet area first.
- **Regular cleaning:** Preserve the beauty of your furniture by lightly vacuuming or using a soft brush regularly, to prevent premature wear and discoloration.
- **Professional attention:** Entrust your fixed-cover fabric sofas and chairs to professional cleaners at least once a year for a meticulous refresh.
